

April 24, 2021

- 1. Approved room and parking lot requests:
 - ~ Flea Market in Painter lot, 4/10/21
 - ~Discipleship class for Primer Amor, Ad. 103, Thursday evenings
 - ~Life Line Screening, Wesley Lounge, 7/30/21
 - ~Red Cross Blood Drive, Wesley Lounge, 5/30/21
- 2. Accepted LIFT Ministries' request to end their rental agreement as of March 31, 2021
- 3. Approved and signed contract with Ireland Sound Systems for installation of live streaming AV equipment, which includes Polaris Lighting Associates as subcontractor
- 4. Approved request of Primer Amor and their Plan of Action to resume indoor worship. (They are following all Conference guidelines)
- 5. Responded to complaints by neighbors about the loud outdoor Worship by Primer Amor
- 6. Created and approved a Plan of Action for resumption of indoor worship by WFUMC following Conference guidelines and sent it to Church Council for approval
- 7. Applied for a loan from the Conference to purchase the Good Shepherd property (which was denied after 2 months of waiting for an answer)
- 8. Hired architect Richard Cisneros to design a plan for a parking lot combining our Administration lot with the Good Shepherd property
- 9. Hired a safe locksmith to repair two locks and replace two locks on three safes and one file cabinet
- 10. Reset security light timers for daylight savings time
- 11. Hired an electrician to replace burned out floodlights in Administration parking lot
- 12. Continued communication with Da Lage Landen Financial Services and Image 2000 regarding the new copy machine.
- 13. Renewed insurance agreement with Philadelphia Insurance Company through HUB International
- 14. Signed an agreement with Bob and Dave's Towing
- 15. Met with Boy Scout Josh, whose Eagle project is to redo the Wesley kitchen, to include painting the walls and renovating the cabinet finish
- 16. Attended a Virtual Ministry zoom workshop
- 17. Attended a Loss Control zoom workshop
- 18. Set goals for future
 - ~installation of major video and lighting technology
 - ~acquisition of Good Shepherd property
 - ~make our facilities more accessible
